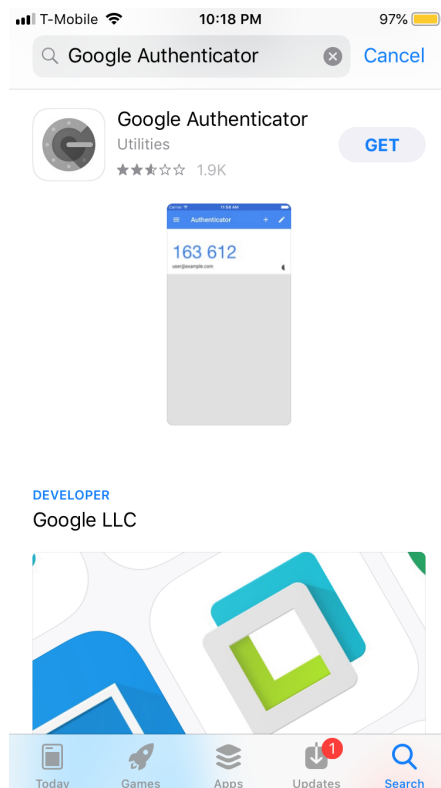


The Google Authenticator application allows you to verify your identity by sending a push notification via the app.

INSTALLING THE GOOGLE AUTHENTICATOR APPLICATION

FOR IPHONE

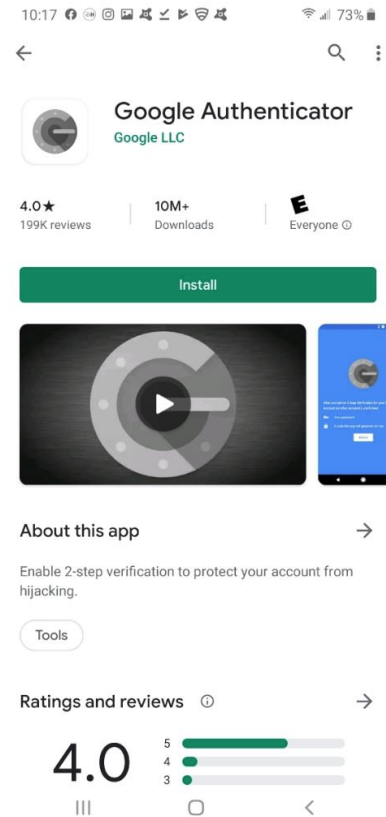
1. Open the App Store and search for “Google Authenticator”. Press the **GET** button to begin the download.



2. Once the download has finished, the application should be available on your home screen. Skip to the “Configure Google Authenticator” section to connect the app to Okta.

FOR ANDROID

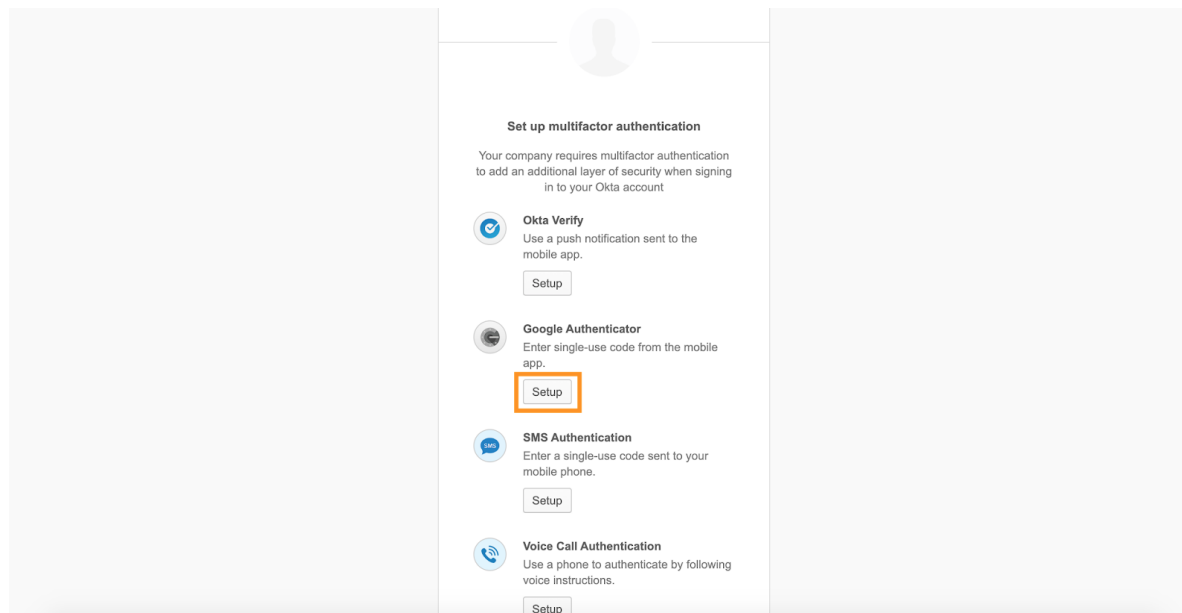
1. Open the Google Play Store and search for “Google Authenticator”. Press the **Install** button to begin the download.



2. Once the download has finished, the application should be available on your home screen. Skip to the “Configure Google Authenticator” section to connect the app to Okta.

CONFIGURE GOOGLE AUTHENTICATOR

1. After logging into SaintsConnect, you will be automatically redirected to the multifactor authentication setup screen. Click the **Setup** button under “Google Authenticator”. Next, select your device type.

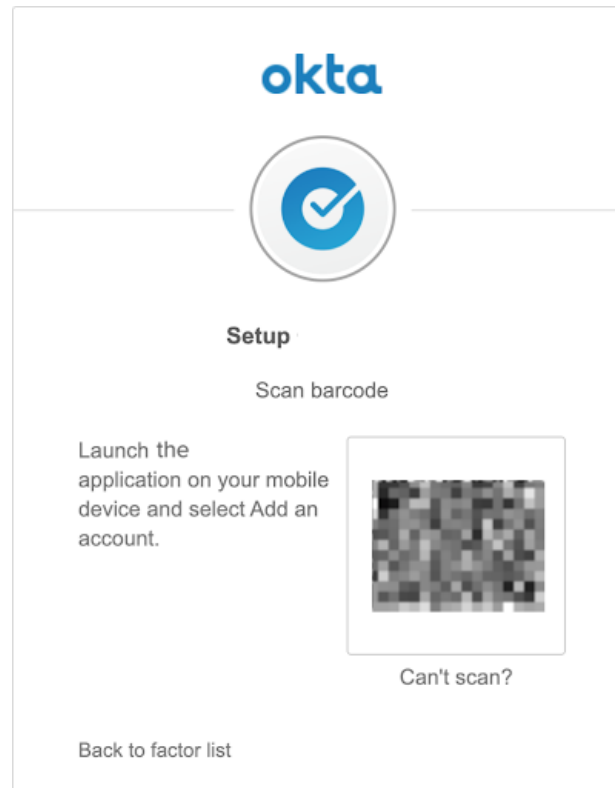


2. In your phone, open the Google Authenticator app and click the **BEGIN SETUP** button at the bottom of the page.

3. If prompted to allow your phone to allow camera access, click **Scan barcode**.


4. On your computer, a QR code will automatically be generated. Point your phone camera towards the QR code to scan it.
 - **NOTE:** For security purposes, the QR code in the figure below is blurred. On your computer, it should appear normally.



5. On your computer, click the blue **Finish** button.



- From now on, every time you log into SaintsConnect, you will see a screen in which you can instruct the Google Authenticator app to send a six-digit verification code to your phone. In your phone, open the Google Authenticator application. You will see a passcode generated by the app. On your computer, enter this code into the text box and click the blue **Verify** button.
